I have informed the President of the information contained in your letter of October 6, 1952, wherein you advise of the excellent technical progress which has been made to date by the FBI Laboratory and the Naval Research Laboratories with respect to the Russian microphone device which was recently discovered in one of our installations in Moscow. It is my understanding that the President has directed the two internal security committees of the National Security Council in collaboration with [redacted]
