CIS Cisco TSG VoIP Ringer and Ring Indicator Information

VOIP Telephones use an analog speaker to provide ring tones. Per the CNSS5001 requirements for "TSG6" approved phones, the speaker element must be disconnected while the telephone is in the "On-hook" condition. A non-speaker "beeper" element has been added to provide an audible indicator for incoming calls.

The call manager provides the available ringtones to the phones. The individual phones ringtones are then selected from the phone itself under settings > user preferences > rings.

The following ring tones yield the best results: a short beep per ring.

- Ring 5
- Are you there 2
- Bass
- Classic ring 1
- Drums 1
